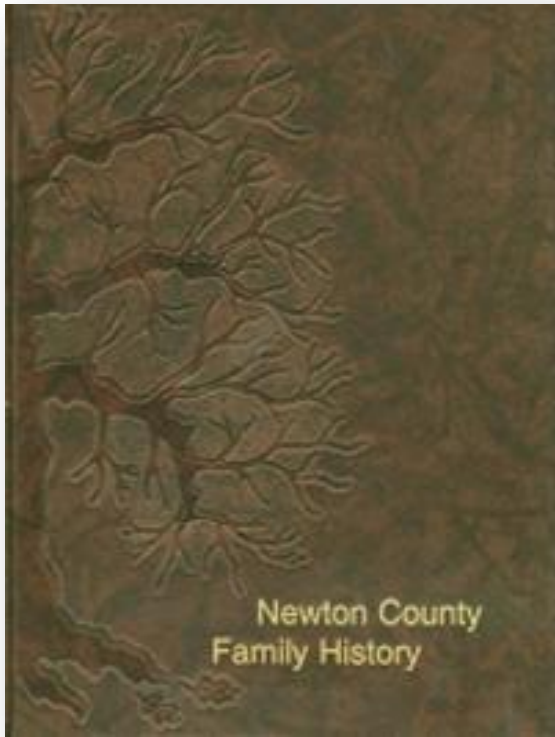

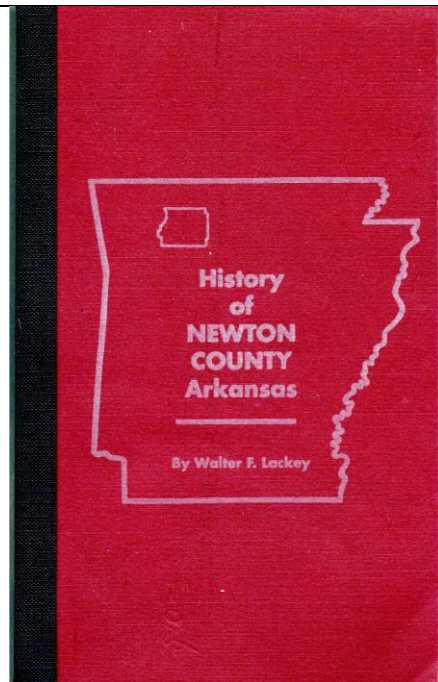


## **Newton County Family History Vol. 2**

## **History of Newton County ©1950**

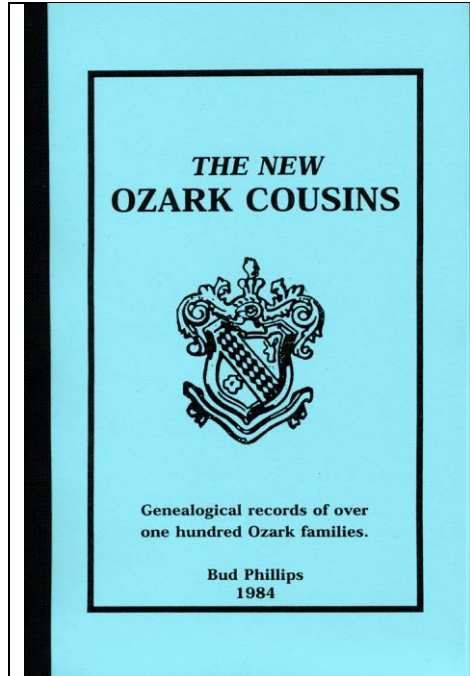

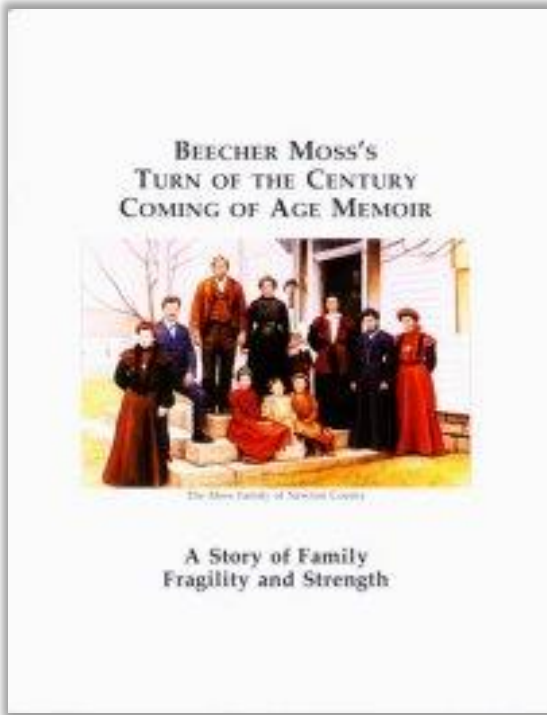
